1st and 2nd Grade

Our Elementary A Courses are designed for 1st and 2nd Grade students to have the opportunity to enrich at home learning in a fun, controlled, educational group setting. These courses are not designed to take the place of your curriculum taught at home, but are designed to add to the things students of this age should be learning at home. We also feel that this gives them some social opportunity to learn while engaging with other students of their same age level.

Elementary History A (Grades 1 and 2)

Wednesday 8:45 – 9:30

This course is designed to give students an overview and love for things that can be studied in History. Topics to include (but not limited to):

- Definitions of community, city, state, and country
- Symbols of America
- Freedoms of America
- Community Helpers
- Early America
- American Holidays

Elementary Science A (Grades 1 and 2)

Wednesday 9:30 – 10:15

This class is designed to teach students love, appreciation, and curiosity about the world God has created around them. Topics will include (but not be limited to):

- A world (including them) created by God
- All about me (appreciation and knowledge of the perfect way God made them)

- Seasons of the year
- Animals
- Plants

Elementary English A (Grades 1 and 2)	
Teacher: Candous Langston	Wednesday 10:15-11:00
This class is designed as an enrichment class for 1st and 2nd grade students. Students will learn the basics of the eight parts of speech, some phonics review, high frequency words, vocabulary, reading comprehension, types of sentences, capitalization and punctuation in sentences, facts about paragraphs and topic sentences, and some poetry memorization.

Elementary Music A (Grades 1 and 2)	
Teacher: Candous Langston	Wednesday 11:15-12:00
This course uses the Orff Method and is designed for 1st and 2nd grade students. Students will use rhythm sticks, shakers, voice, and movements in a variety of songs.	

Elementary Math A (Grades 1 and 2)	
Teacher: Candous Langston	Wednesday 12:00-12:45
This class is designed as an enrichment class for 1st and 2nd grade students. The course will cover addition/subtraction math facts, place value, 2D and 3D shapes, using a ruler, time, measurements, money, perimeter, and basic fractions using manipulatives.	

Elementary Sign Language (Grades 1 through 5)	
Teacher: Candous Langston	Wednesday 12:45-1:30
This is an introductory course for elementary students interested in learning ASL. We will cover etiquette while communicating with the deaf/hard of hearing, the alphabet, numbers to ten, and some basic signs including family, animals, objects, and colors. Students should leave this	

course knowing how to show respect for the deaf/hard of hearing, sign their name, introduce themselves, and exchange basic pleasantries.
